THE HUMMINGFISH FOUNDATION

EAST-TIMOR DEVELOPMENT LANDSCAPE

Marred by a modern history of brutal repression and decades of violence, warfare and poverty, East Timor is shaking off its turbulent past and appears to be on the brink of an era of progress and unity. However, significant economic challenges remain – notably how to alleviate poverty and create economic opportunities especially for women.

The Hummingfish Foundation is working with a group of women in Timor-Leste to help re-brand and export their beautiful line of all-natural soaps, called Ai-Funan, or "flower" in the Timorese language.

Before the Hummingfish Foundation began helping the Ai-Funan ladies re-brand their soap, they sold their product to the domestic market and scraped a meagre living. This re-branding project has added value to their product and given them access to markets in countries all over the world.



Ai-FUNAN - PROJECT RESULTS



The Ai-Funan project is doing is more than helping the ladies of in Ai-Funan generate more income – the project will have a long-lasting impact to their lives and the lives of their families. By turning Ai-Funan into a successful business, The Hummingfish Foundation is also making these ladies role models for other young women in the country.

Coconut, guava, candlenut, frangipani, lemongrass and coffee are the six sumptuous flavours in which these soaps are available and each bar of a Ai-Funan soap is handmade and contains 100% all-natural ingredients including locally-produced organic coconut and palm oils.





Currently several retail outlets in Singapore and Hong Kong carry Ai-Funan soaps and the soaps are also available online (info@hummingfish.org). In the highly successful branding and marketing project, Hummingfish has so far generated significant revenue for these indigenous soap makers by exporting their soaps to high-end markets outside of Timor.

INFORMATION PACK GOILE EDVENTURE NOTES



Day 1, 10th November: Dili

Welcome to the 'City of Peace' and the capital of East Timor. Board the quintessential 'mikrolets' for a quick tour of the city that is set alongside a seafront of azure, blue waters.

The excitement begins - get ready for an evening dive in the famous *Tasi Tulo*! End the day with a refreshing sunset drink at the popular Castaway bar.

Day 2, 11th November: Dives at Secret Garden - K41 - Dili Rock

Dawn dive at *Secret Garden* - the first dive site east of Dili, these coral gardens here are home to a resident *Dugong* and a colourful collection of small reef marine life.

Afternoon dive at *K41* – a popular site where the reef drops straight into the deep on one side and is home to a large variety of sponges, soft corals and plenty of reef fish. The lucky ones can be treated to sightings of White-tip Reef sharks!

Evening dive at *Dili Rock* - Known for its easy access and great conditions it also offers wonderful opportunities to see Leaf Scorpion fish, Angler fish and Ghost Pipe fish.

Day 3, 12th November: Ai-Funan visit in Laquicia Depart for Laquicia to visit the communities and spend most of the day interacting with the women behind the Ai-Funan project - the beneficiary of this adventure challenge. Learn how these beautiful, natural soaps are made. Try your hand at making your own hand-made, organic soap and turn them into personalised gifts for your loved ones!

Get ready to spend the evening and night at a rustic ecolodge - a unique and intimate experience of living close to nature.

Day 4, 13th November: Diving at *Maubara – Bubble Beach – Sandy Bottom*

Dawn dive at *Maubara* – A dive with entry directly in front of Maubara fort, it has a sandy slope and corals with plenty of colourful reef fish.

Afternoon dive at *Bubble Beach* – Also known as the Laquicia Thermal Springs, the springs issue into the sea from the sandy bottom in just 8m of water. Watch out for the blue-spotted rays and reef fish that cluster around patches of coral reefs.

Evening dive at *Dan's Sandy Bottom* – Also known as Gravel Pit, it consists of a gradual slope dive with some great coral gardens. Off to the right is a sand garden with a wide variety of macro critters. This dive-site was discovered by and is named after the founder of Hummingfish Foundation and our guide, Daniel Groshong.

Day 5, 14th November: Atauro Island – Diving at *Outer Reef & Shark Fin*

Depart in the morning to the magical Atauro Island, where water is so crystal-clear that you can see the fish as you arrive!

Afternoon dive at *Outer Reef* – Watch out for the schools of dolphins and pilot whales that may be encountered between Atauro Island and Dili.

Evening dive at *Shark Fin* – Be overwhelmed at this site by the excellent visibility and the abundance of fish life and corals.

Spend the night at Barry's Eco-lodge which has four sundrenched thatched cabins right by the beach!

Day 6, 15th November: *Outer Reef (South) – Manta Cove - Pinnacle*

Morning dive at *Outer Reef (South)* – Explore the remaining hidden secrets of Atauro's underwater world.

Afternoon dive at *Manta Cove* - Set within a towering cliff, this site is famous for its steep drop off and ridges. Best time to dive is in the afternoon when the light passes over through the many ridges creating a spectacular light show.

Evening dive at *Pinnacle* - Located 4km off shore and only accessible by boat, this site's minimum depth is 12m metre and goes down to 40m. It is an amazing meeting place for large pelagics and turtles.

Return to Dili for dinner and drinks at the popular Hotel California.

Day 7, 16th November: Dili - City Experience

After breakfast, hop onto the *mikrolets* for a tour of the city including the famous Cristo Rei, the infamous Santa Cruz Cemetery, the Dare War Memorial and local coffee processing facilities.

Discover the kind of small-town openness that people only fantasize about but seldom experience.

Get lost in culture at the famous Tais market as you shop for traditional Timorese gifts for your loved ones!

Relive the stories and dreams of this magical country and adventure at a special farewell dinner.

Day 8, 17th November: Departure to Singapore

The end of an amazing adventure in East Timor.

What costs do I need to bear?

Your registration payment for this adventure will comprise of **Adventure Fees** which is inclusive of GST:

What is included?

Which diving license should I have to join this adventure?

You must have at least a PADI Open Water Diver license to join this adventure. If you don't yet have a license then do get in touch with us if you need recommendation on which diving instruction schools you can get your Open Water Diver license from.

If I have my own diving equipment, can I get a discount in the adventure fees?

Yes, if you already have your own diving equipment then we will not charge you for it and your adventure fees will be lower than the amount stated above. Please do remember to indicate in our online booking form if you will be bringing your own diving equipment.

How can I fundraise for The Hummingfish Foundation?

Our past adventurers have successfully fundraised in many creative and fun ways. We will send you a comprehensive Fundraising Toolkit upon registration to help you reach your target. You will also have regular support from our Gone Adventurin' team, who will help you develop and manage your fundraising plan, as well as support from the charity for which you are fundraising.

What happens if I don't manage to raise \$\$ 2,000 for the charity?

We encourage all our adventurers to make an honest and determined effort but there are there are no penalties for not reaching the amount. We want each of you have a fun fundraising experience and Gone Adventurin' will support you with as many resources as possible to empower you towards it. Your adventure's team members will also become an informal structure for you to leverage on for ideas and inspiration in reaching towards your goal.

Are there any age limits or specific fitness levels required for this adventure?

The minimum age to participate in this adventure is 18 years at the time of registration.

The difficulty level for this adventure is easy. The adventure involves underwater diving for 5 days with sufficient time for rest in between so there will be plenty of time to relax and even explore parts of East Timor around Dili during the expedition. Please do note that we have experienced local diving guides on hand at all times if you have difficulty on any sections.

Will I get a chance to meet other adventurers before we leave?

Yes, we will organise get-together evening sessions for everyone in Singapore before we leave so no one is a stranger on the flight to East Timor. There will also be regular email and phone communications leading up to the trip. We will also set up an online community on Facebook for this adventure so you can stay in touch with the other adventurers if you're unable to join any of our sessions.

Will I get to meet the communities under The Hummingfish Foundation's Ai-Funan project during this adventure?

Yes, on Day 3 of this adventure we will be visiting the communities and the women entrepreneurs behind the Ai-Funan project. This will give us a deeper insight into the impact of The Hummingfish Foundation's work. You will specifically get to meet and interact with the communities impacted by their projects and also get to try your hand in making organic soaps!
